The Department of Water Resources Releases Floodway Development Review Standards

BISMARCK, N.D. – The North Dakota Department of Water Resources (DWR) has released its Floodway Development Review Standards policy document, available here: <https://www.dwr.nd.gov/reclink/4dcgi/GetPolicyDocument/46>.

The standards provide guidance to community floodplain administrators and engineering firms on the process necessary to comply with federal and state laws related to development within FEMA-mapped floodways. The standards are intended to support consistent review procedures and help communities and consultants better understand floodway development requirements.

To support implementation of the standards, the DWR will host two training sessions in August. The trainings will be offered both in person and virtually.
